



## How to download library ebooks to the Nook

### Software and authorization

1. Download Adobe Digital Editions software from [www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/](http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/).
2. Open Adobe Digital Editions. Follow the steps to sign up for an Adobe account and authorize your computer.
3. Attach your Nook to your computer via USB while Adobe Digital Editions is open. Follow the steps to authorize your Nook.

### Search for library titles

1. Go to [www.bethlehempubliclibrary.org](http://www.bethlehempubliclibrary.org). Click on **ebooks** in Quick Links in the left column; then click **search** to enter OverDrive (the library's ebook collection).
2. Log in and search for titles in any of the following ways:
  - Enter title, keywords or subject in the Search box (left column).
  - Click on **advanced search**.
  - Browse by clicking on **ebook fiction** or **ebook nonfiction** (scroll down left column)
3. Ebook titles will appear with format-specific boxes; we suggest ePub, as it offers more features, but PDF will work, too.

### Borrowing options

- **Check out**  
Click **add to my digital bookbag**, then click **proceed to checkout**. Enter your library card number and click **login**. Click **confirm checkout**.
- **Place a hold**  
The ebook you select might be checked out by someone else. Click **place a hold**; you'll receive an email when the ebook becomes available.

### Download the ebook

1. Click **download**; select **open**.
2. The file will open up in Adobe Digital Editions and refresh your Nook library with the new content. The title will display days left in the loan period.
3. Go to **library view** (click on icon in top left corner). If you can't see your new ebook, click **all items** under **bookshelves**. Drag the book cover from the large panel on the right to the Nook icon in the small panel on the left.
4. Close Adobe Digital Editions; undock the Nook from your computer.
5. In your Nook library, open **My Documents** (Nook) or **My Files** (Nook Color). Overdrive titles show here instead of with Barnes & Noble purchased titles.
6. The title will be available for the time specified on download. After that, it will no longer open and should be deleted from your Nook.
