## **book recycling guide for Bethlehem residents**

### **CURBSIDE RECYCLING**

If you have single-stream curbside recycling service, hard-cover and soft-cover books may be recycled in your bin. Other book recycling options are listed below.

### **GREEN FIBER BINS at the Elm Avenue CDTA Park & Ride**

Hard-cover and soft-cover books may be recycled in these bins (along with most types of paper and cardboard).

### **TOWN OF BETHLEHEM—Rupert Road Transfer Station, South Bethlehem**

**Permit required.** Permits are available **free** for town residents at the Transfer Station during operating hours, or from the Highway Department for town businesses.

The following items may be recycled at the Rupert Road Transfer Station:

- soft-cover books
- insides of hard-cover books (covers must be removed)
- magazines
- newspapers
- office paper/junk mail
- corrugated cardboard and paperboard (flattened)
- glass, plastic containers, metal cans

8am-4pm Tuesday-Saturday (closed some holidays)
