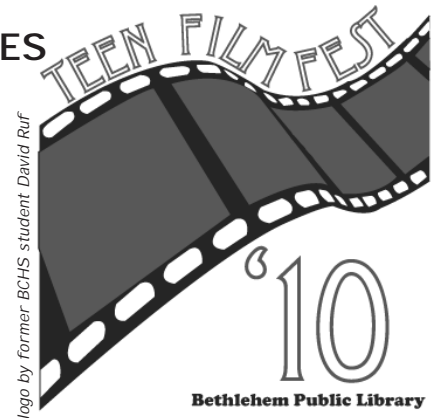

3rd annual TEEN FILM FEST • ENTRY GUIDELINES



FILM CATEGORIES

- action
- comedy
- documentary
- technical/experimental/animation

RULES

- Films must be original, created and produced by teens in grades 6-12. Adults may be used as actors, but may not assist with the creation or production of the film.
- Films must be submitted in DVD format, labelled with all entrants' names. **Films become the property of the library and will not be returned.**
- More than one teen may work on a single film, but **each teen under 18 involved in the production, including actors, must submit an entry form signed by a parent along with the DVD.**
- A teen may enter more than one film, but he/she may enter only one film per category. A separate DVD and a separate entry form are required for each film submitted.
- Films should not be more than 8 minutes long.
- **Any copyrighted material (music, movie clips, etc.) used in the film must be credited.**
- The library reserves the right not to screen all entries at the Film Fest on March 20.
- Finalists must be present at the festival and awards ceremony to be eligible for a prize.

TIMELINE

- February 21, 5pm film entries due
- March 10-13 3 finalists from each category selected by jury for screening at the festival
- March 15-18 finalists notified
- March 20 festival and awards, including "best of the fest" and "people's choice."
