PROGRAMS AND SPECIAL EVENTS

- A four-part series on the Federalist Papers cosponsored by Humanities New York engaged the community and earned the library an award for Adult Program of the Year.
- The Rubber Ducky Club, an early literacy initiative for babies, toddlers and preschoolers, also won an award for Kids and Families Program of the Year.
- A partnership with Bethlehem Senior Services allowed the library to co-host a prom for senior citizens at Town Hall.
- Wi-Fi signal expanded to the Five Rivers
 Environmental Education Center. Use of Wi-Fi at the Town Park continues to climb.
- Customized library card programs allowed patrons to be the stars of their own cards (along with Bad Kitty).
- We added Chromebooks, solar chargers, American Girl dolls, ukuleles, analog video converters and wireless projectors to our Library of Things, which is underwritten by the Friends of the Library.
- Adult programming Coffee and Conversation, co-sponsored by Bethlehem Senior Projects, Inc., touched on music, history, travel and more.
- Extensive outreach brought us into the community and our schools.
- Our annual indoor miniature golf event was free and open to the entire community.
- Summer Reading was a huge hit. Teen volunteers kept everything running smoothly, and adults were encouraged to take part with their very own Bingo reading challenge.
- Both of our long-standing concert series, Evenings on the Green (summer) and A Little Sunday Music (winter), continue to draw large audiences each year. An ice cream social during one of the summer performances is very popular with the community.
- Our meeting rooms are opened for group study before the January and June Regents exams.
- Monthly Listening Parties allow music lovers to explore their favorite artists in depth.


