Born in Ghana, West Africa with one deformed leg, Emmanuel was dismissed by most people - but not by his mother, who taught him to reach for his dreams. He hopped to school more than two miles each way, learned to play soccer, left home at age 13 to provide for his family, and, eventually, became a cyclist. He rode an astonishing 400 miles across Ghana in 2001, spreading his powerful message: disability is not inability. Today, Emmanuel continues to work on behalf of the disabled. *J BIO YEBOAH*
