New York heirloom. Described as "extremely large, early and very prolific" in a 1934 copy of Harris's seeds catalog. Medium-sized plants support loads of large peppers that are mild and sweet.

How to Grow



Sow indoors 6-10 weeks before last frost. Requires heat for germination; can take 10-14 days. Grow seedlings in a warm, well-lit environment; supplemental light usually required. Transplant 3 weeks after last frost in full sun.
