Danvers Carrot

Daucus carota

500 seeds

Days to Sprout:	10 to 14
Days to Maturity:	70
Height at Maturity:	4 to 8 inches
Row Spacing:	12 inches
Plant Spacing:	2 inches
Planting Depth:	¼ inch

Developed in 1871 in Massachusetts, Danvers carrots are deep orange. They average about 6-8" long, but can reach 10" in deep, loose, rock-free soil. Excellent keeper.

How to Grow

Direct sow four weeks before last frost until mid-summer in deeply worked soil. Can take 10 days to germinate. Thin seedlings to 2" apart, then thin baby carrots by pulling out every other carrot; let remainder grow to full size.
