Depth: 1"
Plant spacing: 30"
Row spacing: 4'

Timing:

Direct sow after frost, or start indoors 2-3 weeks earlier. Be sure to sow by early summer to ensure mature fruit by fall.

Transplant in hills spaced 6' apart, 3 plants per hill, or in rows 36" apart. Plants can grow 6' or more, so give plenty of space for the vines to sprawl. Mulch early to help suppress weeds.

Harvest when squash are buff colored with no trace of green. Cure in a dry, warm place for a week or so, then store in a cool, dry, dark place.
