




it was snowing... a LOT!






Sparkle had never seen snow before. She had only read about it in books.

Sparkle saw something glowing!






She went deeper into

Sparkle remembered the necklace she was wearing.


The lady who sold it to her told her that it had magical powers!






Sparkle placed her

The unicorn whinnied to say thank you. The unicorn bent down for Sparkle to climb on her back!






Sparkle and the

rode for hours.






They rode through the forest dotted with plum bushes. The unicorn was happy that she found a friend, and so was Sparkleo
