

Reading Library eBooks on Your Kindle




1. Install the **free Libby app** on your phone or tablet.
Or, use a computer to access the library's digital collection at **libbyapp.com**.



Add a library card for **Upper Hudson Library System** so you can borrow titles and place holds.

Follow the prompts to add a library and sign in.

2. Find a book that you would like to read. Make sure the book is in the **eBook** format. Audiobooks will not work with Kindle.



3. Click on the **cover of the book** to open the details page. Make sure **"Kindle"** is listed under **"Supports."**

4. Select **BORROW**, select your loan period, and select **BORROW** again.



5. Select **OPEN BOOK** and then Choose **Kindle**.
You will be taken to the Amazon login screen.



6. Enter the email and password associated with your Amazon account. This must be the account that you used to register your Kindle.

7. You should see the **name of your Kindle** in the **"Deliver To"** menu. If it looks correct, select **"Get Library Book"**



8. Make sure your Kindle is turned on and connected to a wireless internet (wifi) signal. Your book will be delivered automatically!
